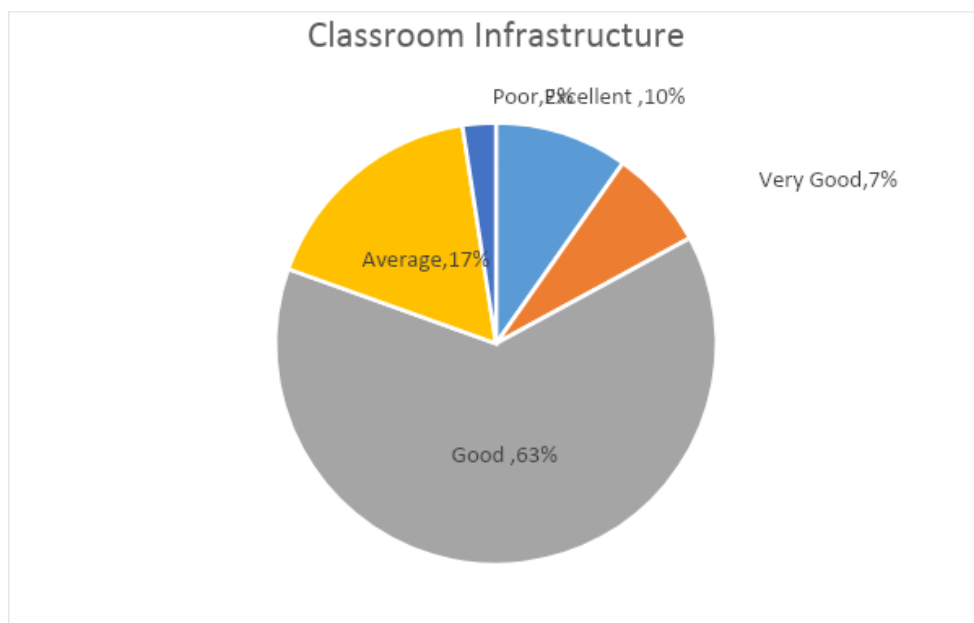

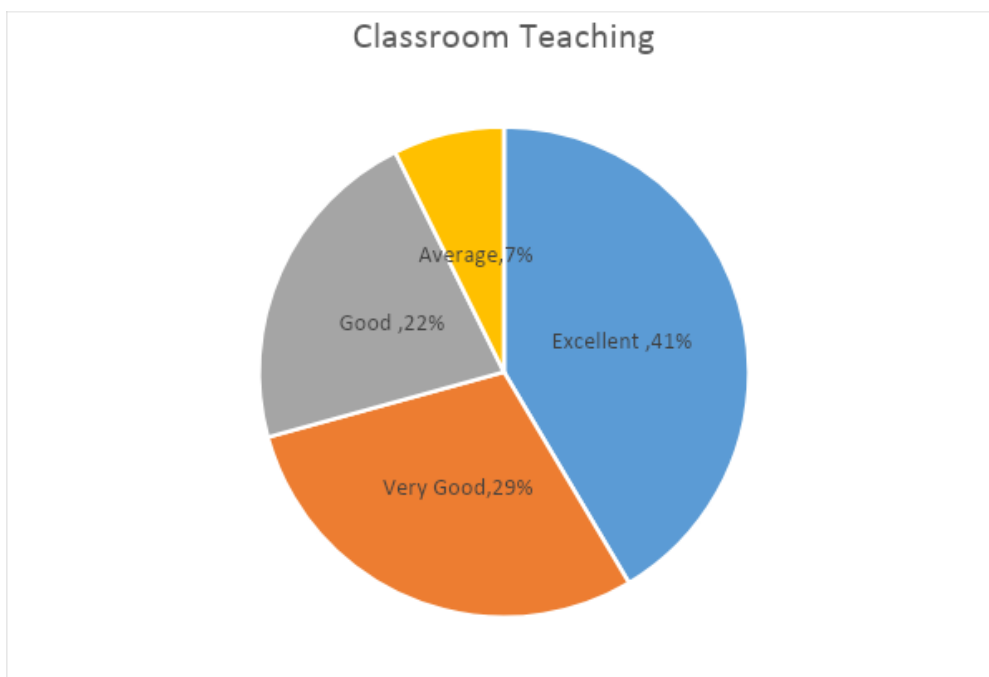

1. OPINION OF STUDENTS ON CLASSROOM INFRASTRUCTURE



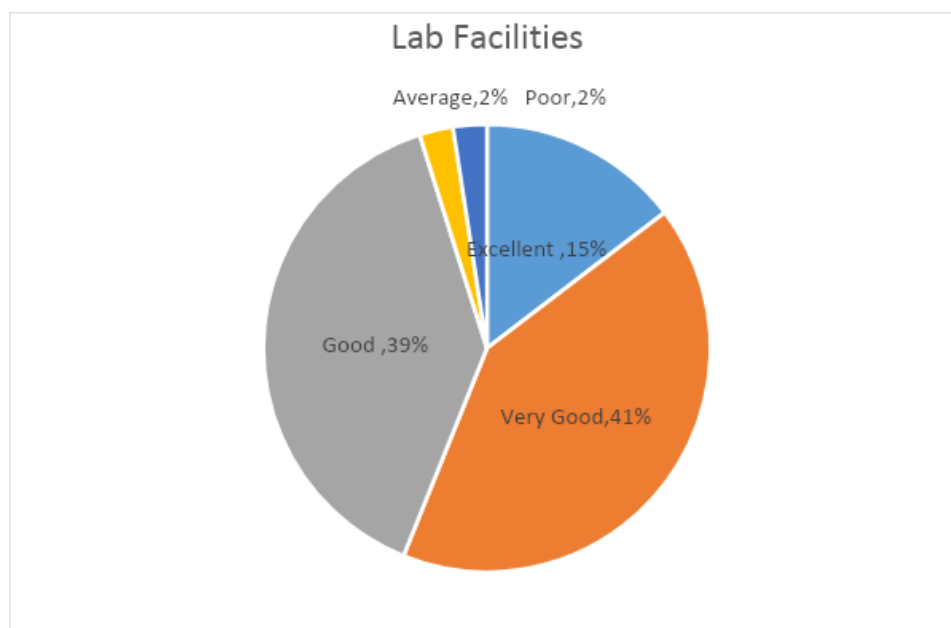
A vast majority (80%) of the participants have the opinion that the college has good classroom infrastructure. However students 20% rate the classroom facilities average or below. This institution should be taking efforts to improve this area.

2. STUDENTS RATING OF CLASSROOM TEACHING



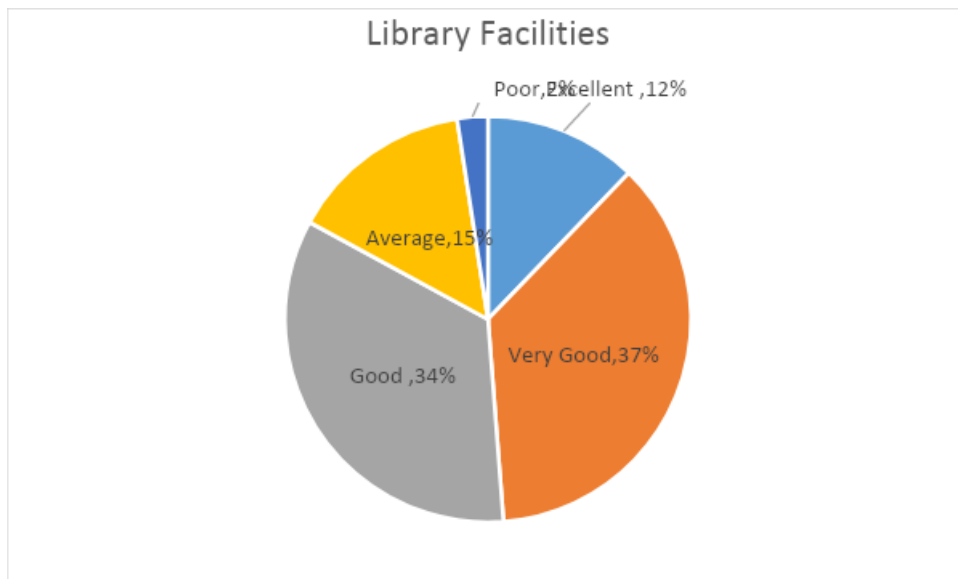
The institution can be proud of the response of 93 % of passing out batch 2014-17 which rates the classroom teaching as good or above. A mere 7% rates it as average. The high satisfaction rate in this indicator is amply reflected by the good results in PU exams.

3. OPINION OF STUDENTS ON LABORATORY FACILITIES



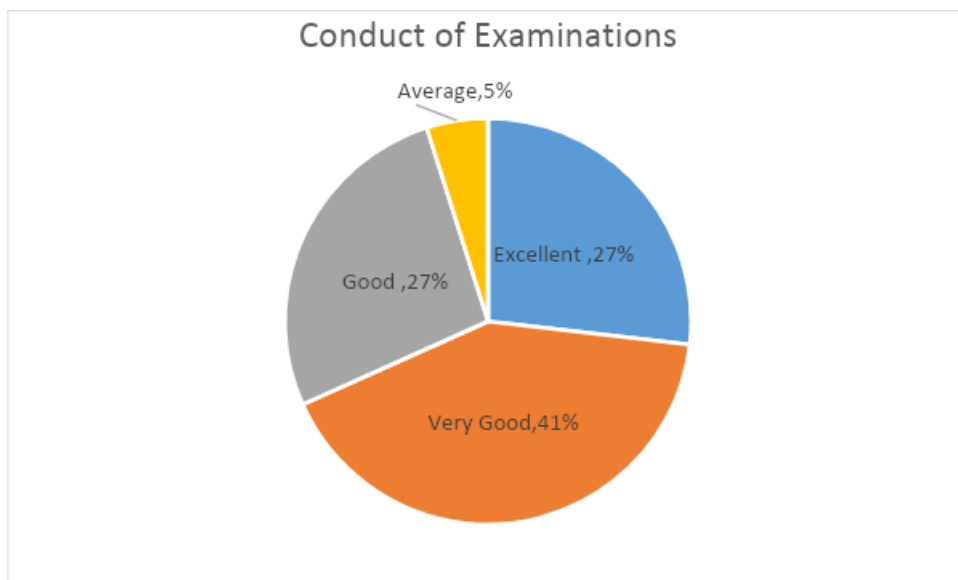
But for a minimal 4% the rest of the outgoing batch says the Laboratory facilities of the college are good or above

4. STUDENTS RATING OF LIBRARY FACILITY



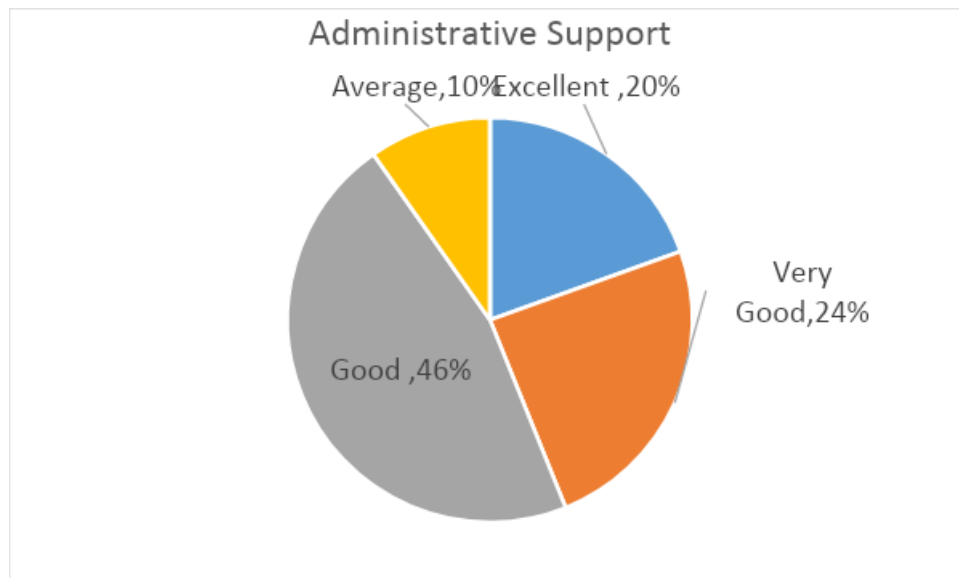
Though the vast majority of the outgoing batch says good about library facilities, 17% rate it average or below. This area requires attention and improvement

5. STUDENTS IMPRESSION ON CONDUCT OF EXAMINATIONS



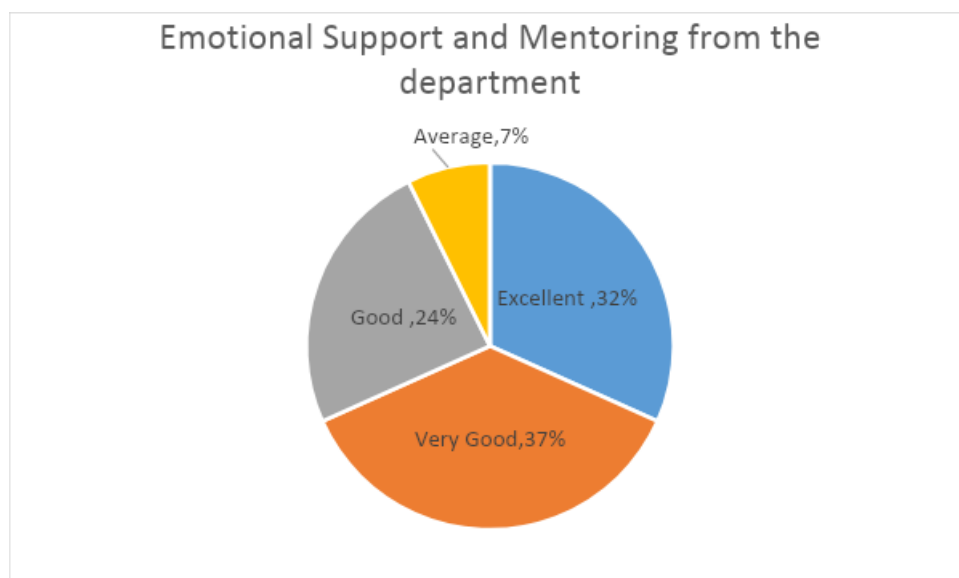
There is a very positive feedback from the 2014-17 batch with respect to the conduct of examinations at IGCAS. 95% of the responses rate the conduct of examination as good or above.

6. OPINION OF STUDENTS ON THE ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT RECEIVED



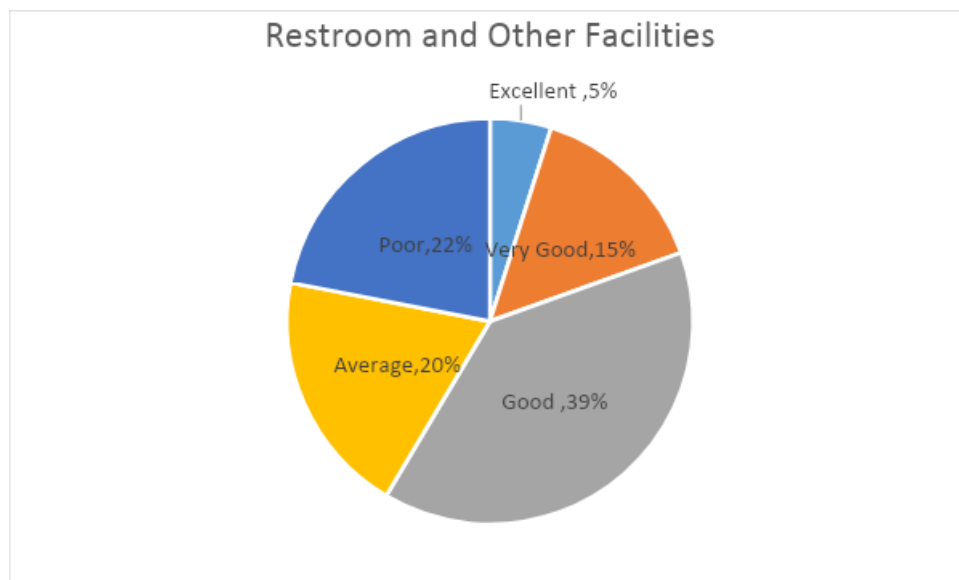
90% of the passing out students think that the administrative support received from the institution was good. This shows a student oriented administration with minor scope for improvement.

7. STUDENTS RESPONSE REGARDING THE EMOTIONAL SUPPORT & MENTORING RECEIVED FROM THE DEPARTMENT



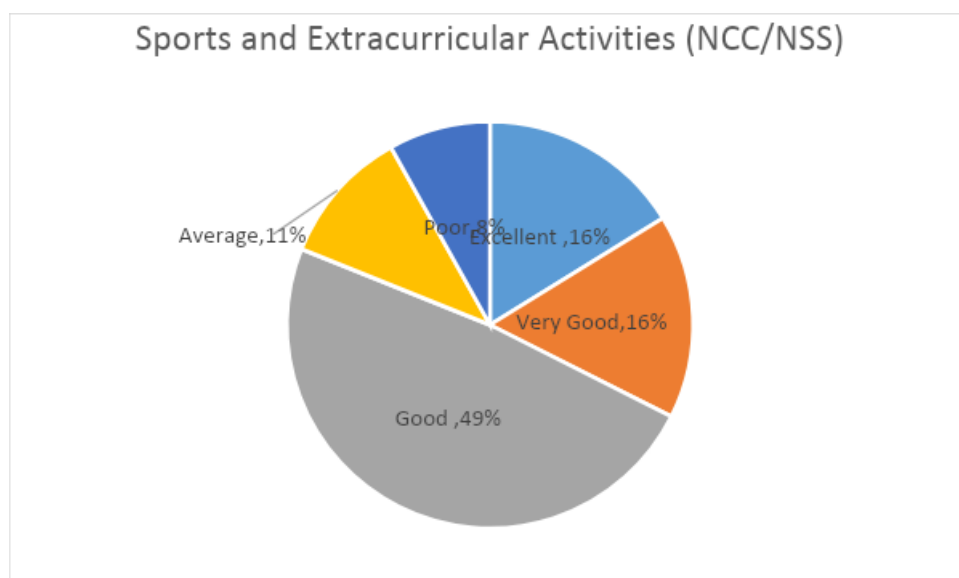
93% of the respondents feel that they received good emotional support and mentoring from their respective departments. This is indicative of the strong mentoring system existing in the institution

8. STUDENTS RATING OF RESTROOM & OTHER FACILITIES



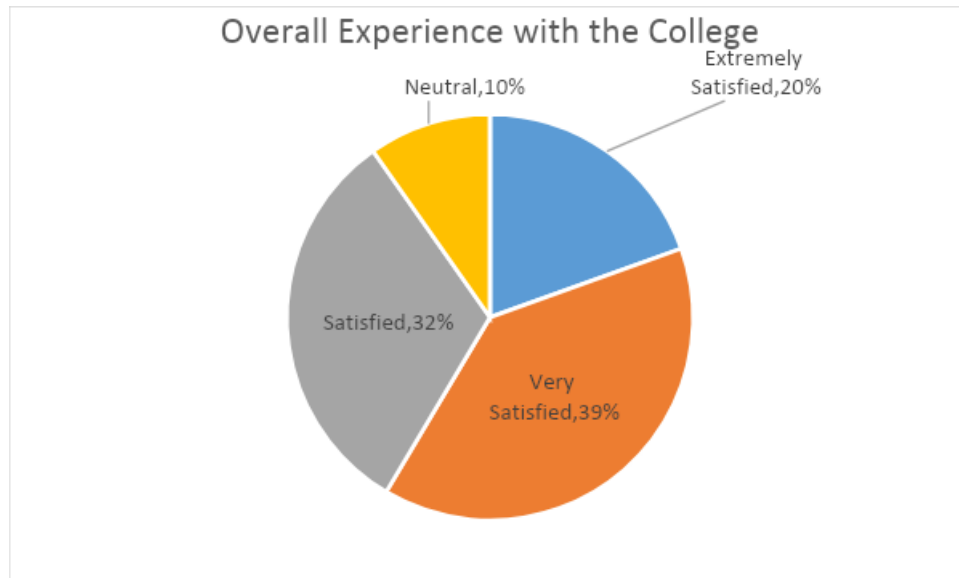
42% of the students rate the rest room and other facilities average or below. Hence this is a grey area that needs immediate attention and improvement.

9. STUDENTS IMPRESSION ON SPORTS AND NSS/NCC ACTIVITIES



81% of the students appreciate the extracurricular activities including Sports/NCC/NSS. 19% of them rated this aspect as average or below. There is scope for improvement in this front as well.

10. OVERALL RATING OF THE COLLEGE BY STUDENTS



90% of the outgoing batch students rate the overall experience with IGCAS as satisfied or above. Among them, 20% are extremely satisfied and 39% are very satisfied. Minor improvements in the facilities will further improve the satisfaction level.

Major suggestions for improvements by students include better Rest rooms, more spacious library and Sports facilities.
